Our events are being attended in record numbers, interesting and exciting events are being planned and new faces are flocking to all events, but . . . membership is down. Don't get caught with your \$5 down!!! Events for all youth groups now have a price for members and one for non-members - the difference is \$5.

For Garin, as dues for this youth group is \$9, you make your money back in two events. For Geshar, their dues are \$18, so you make your money back in four events. ICETY's dues are \$36. \$14 of these dues go directly to NFTY-SC. (Prices quoted are for members of the Temple.) Please note also that since we reinstated the youth group structure three years ago, dues have not gone up and for the foreseeable future will not (tho' when we started NFTY dues were \$11.)

Dues, like for the Temple, must be paid YEARLY. Additionally, with those dues new forms must be filled out. Sometimes emergency contacts change or medical insurance, and even doctors, so please get these in too.

One more reason to make sure your dues are paid . . . for ICETY you cannot go to a NFTY event, that is regional without your dues paid to ICETY. Also for ICETY and Geshar, sometimes we get invited to other youth groups' events. Only members of ICETY and Geshar can go. For those of you who went to OCTY BroomBall, or dances in Beverly Hills, Laguna Hills, Santa Ana and Fountain Valley last year, you know what I am talking about. You don't want to miss out on these!!!
